### What is included

The Global fee covers tuition fees, administration, subject levies, the cost of Yr 7-9 Camps, Yr 11-12 retreats, local and state-wide excursions, swimming & athletics sports, student Accident Insurance, school Magazine (one per family), and other sundry classroom and student-related costs.

### What is not included

Items not covered by the global fee are the optional aspects of the school program, such as Outdoor Ed camps, school production, presentation ball, extra-curricular activities, student electronic device, and the cost of uniform and booklist including e-books. Some external sources of learning may attract a family contribution.

### Family Concessions

The following concessions apply to the tuition fee where two or more siblings attend the College at the same time:

- 10% discount on 2nd child, when 2 siblings attend
- 20% discount on 3rd child, when 3 siblings attend
- 50% discount on 4th & 5th child, when 4 or more siblings attend from the one family.
